Extra Curricular Activities

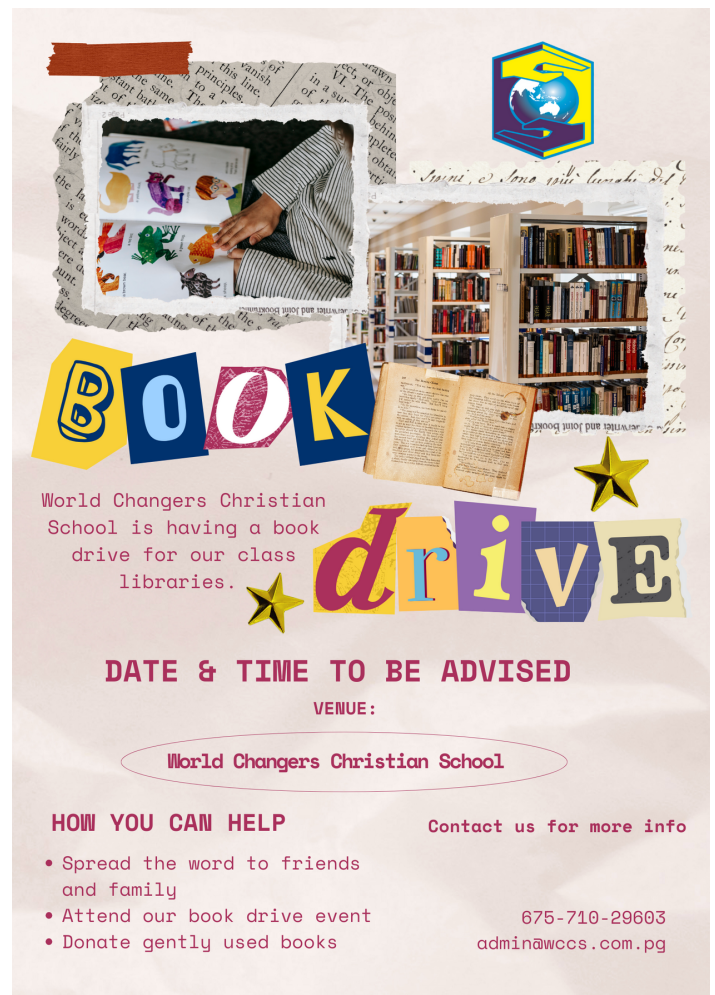
