Requirements:

Students need to be 10 years old (by 2026) or older, be in grade 3 (next year) or higher, complete their termly PACE requirements, and have both their parents and teachers approval to participate. If the student manages to pick an instrument to be studied in 2026, after the audition, they will be sent home with an application form, which is to be filled in by both their parents and supervisor, before selection. Music fee: K100/term.
